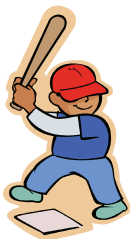

49TH ANNUAL BASEBALL CLINIC

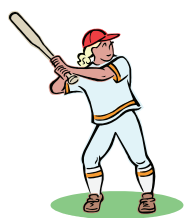
