

# RAC Rules

## Arriving at the RAC

Students should not arrive earlier than 7:30 pm. There is no supervision prior to that time.

## Items Prohibited

Items that may be hazardous to the safety of others are strictly prohibited. Items such as toys, games, radios, tape players and recorders, walk-mans, cameras, water pistols, skateboards, and other articles, should be left at home. Other items **prohibited** are backpacks or any other large bags, hats, glow sticks or outside food or drinks. Food, drinks or candy of any kind is restricted to the food area only. Cell phones are not necessary and we ask that students **not** bring cell phones to the RAC

## Winter Months

If your child wears a winter coat and you do not want to risk the coat stolen, we are asking you to take it from your child upon check in. You must escort your child out at the end of the RAC, you can just bring the child's coat for the child to wear before going out in the cold.

## Student Responsibility

Students share a responsibility for the use and maintenance of all RMS property. They also share responsibility for discouraging vandalism and theft of both personal and public property. Knowledge of these types of incidents should be reported to a staff member or chaperone. Any student guilty of theft or vandalism will face disciplinary action and be responsible for any restitution. Students are also responsible for being respectful to other students, parents, chaperones, and the facility. Students are also responsible for all personal belongings. The RAC is not responsible for lost articles.

## Appropriate Behavior & Inappropriate Behavior

Students are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior. Inappropriate behavior includes the following; disrespecting parents, chaperones, and staff; cursing; hitting; fighting (physical or verbal); kissing; hugging; lap sitting; very physical dance style (grinding); running; horseplay; jumping on backs; break dancing whereby the feet are in the air, dance circles must have a chaperone inside. Students cannot yell out the inappropriate words from songs where such inappropriate words have been bleeped out.

## Appropriate Dress

It is the responsibility of students and their parents to select suitable attire for the RAC. Clothing should not present a health or safety concern, or distraction. The following are additional expectations regarding proper dress: Students' overall appearance will reflect neatness and cleanliness. Clothing must be of reasonable fit. Outer garments must provide adequate coverage of underclothes, no see-through garments, no tube tops, no hats, short skirts, short shorts, midriff shirts, low cut blouses or shirts (whereby the chest is exposed). Clothing that refers to or makes innuendoes to sex, drugs, alcohol, or profanity is not acceptable. Students must wear footwear.

## Harassment and Intimidation

Harassment and intimidation (bullying) are serious and will not be tolerated. (Bullying) means conduct (including verbal conduct) that creates a hostile environment and is motivated by an actual or a perceived personal characteristic such as race, national origin, marital status, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, religion or disability, or is threatening or seriously intimidating.

## Leaving the RAC

**Students are not allowed outside unless accompanied by a parent.** Parents must park their car and enter the RAC to pick up students. Parents must pick up students by 10:00pm. Parents are welcome to walk around the facility and find their child.

## Offenders

There is a zero tolerance for offenders, as these rules are published on the web site and reviewed during online registration. Students who do not abide by these rules will be asked to leave the RAC or isolated until a parent can pick them up or the RAC is over.
